

School Uniform Policy

Uniform is worn at the school and parents agree to support this when they accept a place for their child.

If a pupil is, for some reason, unable to wear the correct uniform on a particular day, a note of explanation is required.

GIRLS

Grey skirt, pinafore or trousers

Red cardigan – *this is a special dye colour and is **only available through the school**.* (Red fleeces, sweatshirts or similar are not acceptable).

White shirt.

School tie – ***only available through the school**.*

White, black or grey socks or tights.

Black shoes – school appropriate (no boots or trainers).

Summer Uniform – White and yellow checked dress

BOYS

Grey school trousers.

Red V-necked jumper – *again this is a special dye colour and is **only available through the school**.* (Red fleeces, sweatshirts or similar are not acceptable).

White shirt.

School tie – ***only available through the school**.*

Grey or black socks.

Black shoes – school appropriate (no boots or trainers).

No jewellery of any description for boys and girls – this includes earrings/ear studs.

For health and safety reasons children are not allowed to wear jewellery in school. This includes hair decorations which can be unsafe in the event of a fall or if worn during P.E.

A tidy hairstyle is an essential part of the uniform. Eccentric styles such as shaved, or with patterns cut into the hair, are not acceptable.

P.E. KIT (boys and girls) *all these (apart from plimsolls) items are available through the school*

Black shorts

Yellow T-shirt

Black plimsolls (trainers may be worn for outdoor games)

Drawstring bag

P.E. Kit must be available each day in school

ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING MUST BE MARKED CLEARLY WITH THE CHILD'S NAME

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Large sports bags are unnecessary and cannot be accommodated in cloakroom areas due to limited space. Children are asked to bring small bags/rucksacks, which can be hung on the hooks provided.
